



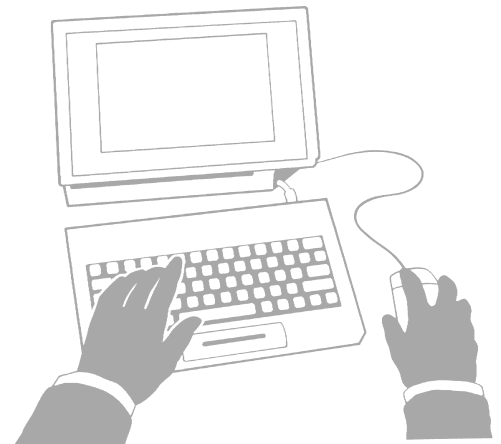

## General Rules:

- Essays should be approximately 500 words.
- Topic must focus on global education in today's society.
- Essays must be typed, double-spaced, and have pages numbered. Include the title on both cover page and essay first page. No author's name or identification on actual essay.
- Because this is not a research paper, but based on the student's own thoughts, ideas, and/or experiences, no works cited page is needed.
- Judging is “blind.” Please place your name, college, classification (freshman or sophomore), instructor, and permanent phone # and address where you can be reached, even during the summer, on the cover page only.
- Deadline for entry submission: August 20, 2010 midnight. One entry per student.
- Student must be enrolled in an Oklahoma community college at the time the essay is submitted.
- Students are encouraged to submit their essays electronically as an e-mail attachment to: sburris@mscok.edu. Please put “OGEC essay entry” in the subject field.
- E-mail attachments as a Word document (.doc) or rich text format (.rtf) are best.
